In recent years there have been significant changes to mental health law. In 2007, the Mental Health Act was amended with significant effects on both service users and professionals and the Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards came into force. In addition, case law continues to refine the law and thus our practice. These changes along with the complex interface between the Mental Health Act and Mental Capacity Act have made it increasingly difficult for practitioners to be confident of their authority for treatment.

This one-day refresher course is **accredited by the East Midlands and Yorkshire Regional Advisory Panel** as a refresher course for **Section 12 approved doctors** and **Approved Clinicians** and is valid for those attending from other parts of England. It is also designed to deliver the regulatory requirement for annual further relevant training essential for **DoLS Mental Health Assessors**. It will provide an update on statutory changes as well as significant case law and is recommended for all who wish to update their knowledge of mental health law.

- ✧ Apply to renew your Section 12 / Approved Clinician approval through your local approvals office
- ✧ Demonstrate further relevant training to continue to act as a DoLS Mental Health Assessor
