Malcolm Taylor was with the Crown Prosecution Service since its inception in 1986 until he retired at the end of 2014. His areas of expertise include homicide, shaken and battered babies, corporate manslaughter, large and complex fraud, undercover investigations, and unusual and sensitive cases. He most relevantly took a case on fitness to plead all the way to the House of Lords shortly after the current legislation came into force.

Dr Mike Ventress is dual trained in forensic and adult psychiatry. He has worked in both medium and low secure settings as a consultant forensic psychiatrist for ten years. He has substantial experience in providing opinions for solicitors, courts and the Crown Prosecution Service in respect of fitness to plead, often in complex cases. He has a particular interest in mental health law and has a Master's degree in the subject. He is co-author of a paper on fitness to be interviewed published in Advances in Psychiatric Treatment.
