He founded and leads the CNWL Club Drug Clinic, a specialist service for users of so-called 'legal highs' and other drugs such as MDMA, ketamine and mephedrone. National roles include clinical advisor to Public Health England. He is currently associate registrar for policy support and was previously Chair of the Faculty of Addictions at the Royal College of Psychiatrists.
