The Autism Diagnostic Interview, Revised (ADI-R) is a structured interview used for diagnosing autism, planning treatment, and distinguishing autism from other developmental disorders. Used in research for decades, this comprehensive interview provides a thorough assessment of individuals suspected of having autism or other autism spectrum disorders. The ADI-R has proven highly useful for formal diagnosis as well as treatment and educational planning.

This three-day course will train you in the use of the Autism Diagnostic Interview (ADI-R). On completion you will receive a certificate stating you are trained to use the ADI-R clinically in your day-to-day assessments.

This course aims to provide delegates with:

- Use the ADI R clinically in your day to day assessments
- Assess service users reliably through use of ADI R
- Know what to do next to become reliable in the ADI R for use in research or to train your team.

Programme:

Day 1:

Introduction to ADI-R and Familiarisation with instrument Demo full administration and coding discussion

Day 2:

Live administration of ADI-R with volunteer Coding and consensus discussions

Day 3:

Video demo and coding

Bringing it all together: administration and coding

About out speaker:

Dr Carol Stott is a Chartered Psychologist (CPsychol) and Chartered Scientist (CSci) and a member of the British Psychological Society. She has an MSc in epidemiology from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and a PhD in the epidemiology of Specific Language Impairment from the University of Cambridge. Carol spent 13 years in the University of Cambridge Department of Psychiatry carrying out research into genotype-phenotype associations in developmental disorder and with the University of Cambridge Autism Research Centre (ARC) investigating the population frequency of Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASDs).
