About this course

Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) is a neurodevelopmental condition characterised by persistent patterns of inattention, hyperactivity, and impulsivity that impacts functioning in Adults. In the UK, NICE NG87 (2018) provides a comprehensive framework for the diagnosis and management of ADHD. Despite increased awareness, gaps remain in recognition, especially in women, and those with co-occurring mental health conditions—highlighting the need for better training and service provision.

This course will provide an up-to-date, clinically relevant overview of ADHD in Adulthood with a focus on assessment, diagnostic challenges, and comorbidities. We will cover DIVA-5, explore differential diagnoses and touch on cultural, neurobiological, and psychosocial aspects of ADHD. The workshop will also highlight considerations for treatment and management. We will talk about learnings from real cases.
