This workshop will cover what constitutes bullying and cyberbullying, based on the latest research. Will examine and discuss the factors that play a role into victimisation, both at school and online. Will also examine the various types of bullying that lead to mental health difficulties. And will explore and report the consequences of such victimisation during adolescence and adulthood, as a result of continuous and severe bullying.

After attending this course delegates will be able to....

- Familiarise with the risk and preventive factors for bullying victimisation
- Understand the short-term and long-term consequences of victims
- Familiarise with efficient strategies and approaches for supporting victims of bullying as well as preventing bullying online and offline as a whole.

About our speaker:

Dr Calli Tzani is a Senior Investigative Psychology and Clinical Forensic Psychology Lecturer at the University of Huddersfield. Dr Tzani was originally trained as a clinical psychologist in 2005, in Greece, where she graduated with BA in Psychology from the University of Indianapolis. She now holds a masters in Investigative Psychology, a PhD in Psychology, is a fellow of the Higher Education Academy and BPS Chartered Psychologist. She is a member of several advisory bodies, including the Institute on Crime and Criminal Justice Policy, European Public Law Organisation (EPLO), the Psychologist British Psychological Society, Member of the Youth Mentoring Listserv, Member of the School Ethics Research Panel (SREP) at University of Huddersfield, Fellow of the NLP International Society. Dr Tzani is also reviewing for several scientific journals, such as the Journal of Investigative Psychology and Offender Profiling, the International Journal of Offender Therapy and Comparative Criminology, Psychology & Psychiatry, International Journal of Bullying Prevention, and Journal of Generic Psychology. Dr Tzani specialises in Investigative Psychology, Offender Profiling, Victim Support, Violent Acquisitive and Sexual Crime, Clinical Forensic Psychology, Psychology of Crime Prevention and self-harm, Improving Legal Testimony and Evidence in Court and Investigations and Professional Issues and Applications. She has supervised over 100 MSc research projects and is currently supervising PhD projects on Sexual Offending Against Children, Stranger Sexual Killer, Radicalisation Language of Extremist Groups Online, Terrorism, and Juvenile Rehabilitation. She has conducted research on various areas of psychology and criminology and has published numerous scientific articles on peer reviewed journals, such as the Journal of Investigative Psychology and Offender Profiling, the Journal of Environmental Research and Public Health, Computers in Human Behavior, New Ideas in Psychology, the International Journal of Bullying Prevention, the International Journal of Cyber Criminology, and many others. Dr Tzani has also contributed to media coverage multiple times, such as The Conversation, BBC, The Independent, The Examiner, New Zealand Herald, Daily Mail, World News, and many other. She has presented in various conferences globally, contributed to numerous funded projects and collaborates with scientists all over the world.
