





# **Epilepsy: A Clinical Update**

The first session of the talk will include an overview of the epilepsy epidemiology, an update of the latest ILAE classification of seizures and epilepsies, a summary of the different aetiologies, including genetic, structual, metabolic, infectious, immune and neurodegenerative. The second session will provide a summary of diagnostic tools and some examples for each aetiological category. The third session with focus on treatment strategies, including available evidence-based therapies and tailored treatment guided by aetiology when possible. The final session will include clinical cases to be discussed with the audience.

After attending this course delegates will be able to:

- Initiate appropriate diagnostic work up
- Recognise underlying epilepsy aetiology
- Consider most appropriate treatment options

## **About the Speaker:**

**Simona Balestrini** is Associate Professor of Child Neurology and Psychiatry at the Neuroscience Department, Children's Hospital A. Mayer, and University of Florence. She is also Consultant Neurologist at the Chalfont Centre for Epilepsy and National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, UCLH, and Senior Clinical Research Fellow at UCL Queen Square Institute of Polytechnic University of Marche, Ancona, Italy. During her specialty training she undertook a "Claudio Munari" Epilepsy Surgery Unit, Niguarda Hospital, Milan, Italy with focus on neurophysiology and surgical treatment of epilepsy. She subsequently was awarded a PhD for her research on SUDEP. She has a special interest in epilepsy genetics, and runs epilepsy clinics and epilepsy genomics clinics both in Italy and in the UK. Her current research focuses on the application of genomics to understand the causes, course and treatment response of epilepsy.
