- Understand current developments in mental health legislation and apply this knowledge practically to your clinical work

The 2007 amendments to the Mental Health Act (MHA) 1983 defined the Approved Clinician as: "A person approved by the appropriate national authority to act as an approved clinician for the purposes of the MHA". The MHA Approved Clinician (AC) (General) Directions 2008 introduced the need for specific training to be delivered to those professionals who will assume the role of an AC.

To attend this course you must have met, or be working towards the competencies required of an AC (National Health Service Act 2006, MHA AC Clinician (General) Directions 2008).

This is approved as the required course for those practicing in England. Attendance at this course is only one part of the approval process. Please contact your local S12/AC Administrator for full criteria for approval, and how to apply.
