





# **An Introduction to Acceptance and Commitment Therapy**

Acceptance and Commitment Therapy is an empirically based intervention which introduces a range of strategies to increase psychological flexibility. It is part of the 'third wave' development of the cognitive behavioural school pf psychotherapy which now incorporates tools such as acceptance, mindfulness, cognitive defusion and committed action. ACT is commonly used within the NHS to work with sufferers of chronic pain, anxiety and depression.

This training will briefly introduce participants to the theory and research behind Acceptance and Commitment Therapy and introduce the concept of Psychological Flexibility. It will be an experimental session that will cover the 6 core processes of ACT. Participants will leave with ideas and tools for use with their clients, patients and themselves.

#### This course aims to provide delegates with:

- An overview of the theory underpinning Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (Relational Frame Theory)
- Understand the 6 core concepts of ACT
- Have practical tools to use in a variety of settings with a range of presenting problems

### **About our speaker:**

**Dr Rebekah Olive,** Clinical Psychologist, Health and Care Professions Council, PYL24259, has been working as a Clinical Psychologist in private practice since 2011. She has training in cognitive behavioural therapeutic interventions including the third wave models Compassion Focused Therapy and Acceptance and Commitment Therapy. She has applied her knowledge to a range of psychological difficulties including OCD, PTSD, anxiety disorders and depression. She is also experienced in working with survivors of childhood abuse and sufferers of eating disorders. Her training in Acceptance and Commitment Therapy came from Dr Russ Harris, a world renowned trainer of ACT. She has used ACT extensively with her clients and has found it a cross-diagnostic model that applies to the lives of many and varied individuals.
