This talk aims to promote acceptance of people on the autistic spectrum by helping others to understand what it really means to be autistic. Improved training around autism is at the heart of the autism strategy for all public service staff, but particularly for those working in health and social care. This workshop focuses on enhancing autism understanding through discussion of how autistic people experience the world around them. It promotes the idea that people with autism are better served not by viewing autism as a disorder or condition, but by accepting it as a different way of thinking.

This course aims to provide delegates with:

- Recognise the challenges autistic people face on a day to day basis
- Understand why autistic people may behave in certain ways
- Think about ways they can support autistic people they come into contact with

About our speakers:

Pete Hughes, CEO, Leeds Autism Services

After training and working in mental health settings, Pete joined Leeds Autism Services as a support worker in 2001 and has since undertaken a number of roles within the organisation, becoming CEO in late 2017. With nearly 20 years' experience working solely in the field of autism, Pete has worked with over 100 autistic adults and their families. During that time, he has gained a unique insight into the shared traits which define such a diverse group of people as being 'autistic'. Pete is a passionate believer in the positive recognition and equal rights of autistic people.

Gina Lewis, Autistic Adult and Employee at Leeds Autism Services

Gina's interest in human behaviour started at a young age and led her to study psychology, gaining her a 2.1 BSC Hons in psychology. After working with mental health and learning disability services for 5 years, Gina's developed a special interest in Autism, leading her to seek out a position at Leeds autism services in 2014. A challenging time in Gina's life in 2017 led to a period of self reflection and extensive research into the newest understandings of autism, in particular, how it manifests in girls and women and atypical presentations of spectrum disorders, such as PDA.
