Bipolar Disorder is widely underdiagnosed. People with this condition wait on average 10 years or more before receiving the diagnosis. The majority of Bipolar Disorder symptoms start in the adolescence. However determining the difference between typical teenage behaviour and behaviour that is a result of Bipolar Disorder is difficult for even the most experienced professionals. Bipolar Disorder is often misdiagnosed as depression. As a consequence patients may be given inappropriate treatment. Improved detection could lead to significantly improved outcomes for people with underlying, but unrecognised Bipolar Disorder. The session will explore most common reasons why it is hard to distinguish Bipolar Disorder from other mental health conditions. It will cover differences in presentation in teenagers and most common misdiagnosis (Major Depression, Borderline Personality Disorder, ADHD). Cases will be used to discuss different presentations, clinical dilemmas and differential diagnosis. Service user perspective will be presented.

- Understand most common diagnostic difficulties and misdiagnosis
- Have a service user perspective

About our speaker:

After gaining her 1st degree in General Adult Psychiatry in Poland Dr Anna Kucharska MD, PhD Consultant Adult and Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist Independent Practice, completed 3 years as a trainee on the St Mary's General Psychiatric Training in London. She has returned to Poland and worked in Regional Eating Disorders Unit for number of years. In 2004 she obtained PhD and published around 54 publications in both polish and international journals. She also wrote a chapter in a book on mental health problems in partially deaf people. On return to UK in 2005 Anna was appointed as a Consultant in General Adult Psychiatry. In 2006 she has moved to field of Child and Adolescent psychiatry. For last 13 years she has worked as a Consultant in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry in Northumberland, Tyne and Wear NHS Trust and South West Yorkshire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust. She also worked as a Locum Consultant for PULSE and Medax. She became interested in Mood Disorders in young people few years ago after a member of her family was diagnosed with Bipolar Affective Disorder.
