Based on the work of Prof Paul Gilbert (OBE) this interactive introductory workshop aims to help you learn more about CFT and understand more about our tricky brains and ways to manage them. Starting with developing a clear understanding of compassion what it is and why it is so important we will consider some of the blocks to compassion and ways to work with these blocks. Using compassionate mind training practices in the workshop and we will consider and experience how they may be used to support our own well-being and the well-being of others.

After attending this course delegate will be able to:

- Understand more about compassion and why we need it.
- Learn more about how our three systems of emotional regulation work and use them when thinking about ourselves and others
- Experience some compassionate mind training exercises personally and consider how we might use them clinically.

About our speaker:

Maria Law-After many years of working clinically with predominantly adults, I became a lecturer teaching CBT at The University of York, training clinicians to become CBT Psychotherapists it was only on leaving this and returning to clinical practice that I gave myself time to fully engage with Mindfulness and Compassion Focused Therapy. I have benefitted hugely from this and over the last six years this self-practice using compassionate mind training has become a vital part of my life and well-being. I continue to use CFT clinically within individual therapy, group therapy and through the training and supervision of other clinicians. Over the last four years I have been project lead for the compassion in schools project which is based on DR Mary Welford's pioneering work using CFT as a whole school approach. Mary has supervised me in this work. More recently I have been using CFT with organisations going through change and this has been a whole staff approach offering compassion training and meditation sessions within the workplace.
