Led by **Dr Matthew Gaskell**, this introduction to gambling addiction will provide healthcare professionals with greater understanding of gambling addictions, the determinants of harm, the consequences of harm, co-morbidity and treatment. It will also provide non-specialists with ways to identify gambling problems and intervene if specialist treatment is not required. A case example of gambling addiction will be provided. It will include an outline of the new NHS Northern Gambling Clinics.

Matt Gaskell leads the NHS Northern Gambling Service. This covers the whole of the north of England from the north Midlands to the Scottish border, with regional clinics in Manchester, Leeds and Sunderland. He is an advocate for reform of gambling regulation and legislation, working with the House of Lords, Parliament and the Northern Ireland Assembly. He was programme manager for the degree programme in addictions at University of Leeds for many years, and he is visiting lecturer in addiction at Doctoral level for the University of Birmingham and University of Leeds. He has twenty years' experience working with people with long term and complex addiction presentations, and has been clinical lead with the Leeds Addiction Unit for many years. His research interests include the nature of addiction, treatment and recovery, and public health approaches to preventing and minimising harm.
