Chronic Pain is common and a leading cause of disability in the UK and abroad. Medical and surgical treatments are of limited value, and sometimes actively problematic (e.g. opioids). Psychological treatments are accepted as effective; mental health professionals have relevant skills in this area, and yet can alienate patients with the wrong approach.

Course Objectives

- Understand key points from 50 years of chronic pain research
- See how psychological techniques can be applied, how to frame the goals of treatment (and how not to)
- Reflect on how to work with colleagues in pain and community services

About our speaker

Dr Jeremy Gauntlett-Gilbert, Principal Clinical Psychologist at Bath Centre for Pain Services, will summarise the key science on chronic pain, which is poorly understood outside of pain specialty settings. We will look at the role of psychological approaches, the goal of treatment and how to engage the patient. Examples of acceptance and values-based techniques will be demonstrated.
