Typically it is more difficult to diagnose females who are autistic. This starts at the diagnostic criteria and also the way in which autistic females typically mask. Understanding and accepting this point will aid professionals to look more broadly at the subject and autistics themselves to understand more about themselves, and their place in the world. Learn about the differences between male and female presentations, how they can be misread and the tools that are used to blend in with their surroundings. Support to encourage less masking is also included.

After attending this course delegates will be able to:

- Know what the autistic female presentation is
- Understand how it differs to the male presentation
- Know how and why autistics mask
- Support peers/friends to mask less

Sam Ramsay, Manager, Curly Hair Project. I have worked with autistic children, young people and adults for the past 9 years, including personal experience of having an autistic daughter. My work has taken me to speak at NAS conference and on BBC Radio 4, explaining the understanding of autism and how it presents. I now also work within a CAMHS setting, providing support to autistics in crisis. My interests include not only autism but those who have eating difficulties (disorders and disordered eating) and ADHD too.
