





# Treating Anxiety Disorder with Intensive Short-Term Dynamic Psychotherapy

This one-day workshop will provide an overview of the theoretical framework of ISTDP and the ways in which this approach is used to treat anxiety disorders. The unique elements of the model will be highlighted, including: the emphasis on the somatic experience of emotions in the here and now; monitoring unconscious signalling of anxiety in the body; and an active approach to maladaptive defence mechanisms. The emphasis will be on understanding of unconscious anxiety symptoms and ways in which these can be effectively diagnosed and regulated in order to work safely within patients' range of tolerance to improve therapeutic outcomes. Video presentations of clinical sessions will be shown to demonstrate the key principles of this technique.

- Understand the theoretical framework of ISTDP
- Identify the manifestations of unconscious anxiety and understand how these symptoms can be used for di agnostic purposes
- Use targeted techniques to regulate anxiety

# About our speaker:

**Dr Lewis** is a chartered clinical psychologist registered with the British Psychological Society and the Health and Care Professions Council. She has worked both in private practice and in the NHS and has a particular interest in treating patients presenting with anxiety difficulties and treatment-resistant depression, as well as those diagnosed with physical health conditions such as auto-immune disorders, fibromyalgia and chronic pain. Dr Lewis has extensive experience in training clinicians in advanced psychotherapy skills, in particular ISTDP. She is an accredited trainer and supervisor with the International Experiential Dynamic Association (IEDTA) and is currently a visiting lecturer at the University of Hertfordshire.
