Dr Saju, is a Consultant Psychiatrist with post graduate qualifications in CBT and Family Therapy. He has worked as a General Adult Psychiatrist and also as a specialist in various sub specialities (Liaison Addictions, Gender Dysphoria). He has worked in therapeutic communities and various secondary care psychotherapy services in Yorkshire. He has particular interest in brief therapies, and uses ideas and skills from different therapy models in his practice. Dr Saju believes all clinicians have the potential to develop their therapeutic capabilities further. He is also a psychotherapy trainer and supervisor. Dr Saju has written chapters on CBT and Systemic Family Therapy in the book "Seminars in the Psychotherapies" series published by the Royal College of Psychiatrists.
