Neuropsychiatry is a tertiary branch of psychiatry with a primary focus on diagnosing and treating psychiatric complications of known or suspected neurological disease/acquired brain injury.

Another key area of practice involves carrying out diagnostic work where psychiatric presentations have atypical qualities and are suspected to be associated with organic disease. Specialist areas of practice include epilepsy, tic disorders, neurodegenerative disease, sleep medicine, traumatic brain injury and functional neurological disorders.

This course will allow delegates to obtain a practical overview of core topics in neuropsychiatry, including movement disorders, epilepsy, traumatic brain injury and inflammatory brain disease.

About our speaker:

Dr Rachel Thomasson and Dr Richard Hackett are practising consultant Neuropsychiatrists in one of the largest tertiary Neurosciences centres in the UK. They collaborate on cases across a broad range of neurosciences disciplines in addition to regional centres of excellence in clinical genetics, oncology and metabolic medicine. General clinics are focused on diagnosis and treatment of neuropsychiatric aspects of known or suspected neurological disease (Neuroinflammatory and neurometabolic disease, brain tumours, epilepsy, dementia, movement disorders and acquired brain injury). They also collaborate with psychiatrists in secondary care to investigate psychiatric presentations that have a suspected organic basis. Dr Thomasson is involved in setting national training standards for Neuropsychiatry as part of the curriculum working group of the Royal College faculty of Neuropsychiatry and Dr Hackett leads the Neuropsychiatry teaching programme for NHS Health Education England – Northwest.
