## **About this course**

The workshop address the links and connections between self-harm and suicide, but also treats these as independent constructs. The workshop is designed to be interactive, thought provoking and practical with the presenter having written pamphlets and designed a self-harm tool-kit for discussion and distribution. The morning session will consider suicide attempts and suicide with the afternoon session focusing upon self-injury with a special emphasis upon self-cutting. It is hoped that delegates will bring there own expertise and own clinical stories to the event.

- Have a deeper understanding and increased knowledge of self-harm and suicide
- Know and reflect upon the warning signs of suicide
- Reflect upon theory, practice and research and how these interact and implement contribute to clinical practice.

# About our speaker

Dr **Terence** Nice is **Emeritus** Programme Director (Psychotherapy) at the University of Kent and a Visiting Lecture at Regent's University London. He trained as a psychoanalytic psychotherapist at the University of Kent before going onto the MA in infant observation at the Tavistock Clinic, London. He has always been fascinated by early development experiences and how these impact upon adolescent and adult psychopathology. Since completing his doctoral thesis 'Troubled Minds and Scarred Bodies' in 2012, his research focus has been upon capturing and understanding the complex intentional and motivational systems that characterise self-harming and suicidal behaviours in young people. He contributed to the development of the Mind and Body Programme, winner of the UK Public Mental Health and Well-being award (2017). He is a practicing psychotherapist and an active researcher. He has published papers on self-harm and attempted suicide in young people and is a reviewer for the British Journal of Psychotherapy. Dr Nice has developed his own treatment programme, Equilibrium, for young people who self-harm and attempt suicide which he has clinically conducted in the NHS.
