





Managing Addictions & Treatments: Drug and Alcohol

The purpose of the talk is to update the attendees on addictions assessment and management. The talk will mainly cover drug (including novel psychoactive substances and club drugs) and alcohol use disorders, harms of addiction, causes of addiction, screening and specialist assessment for addictions and biopsychosocial interventions for addictions.

- Prevalence of substance use, harms associated and causes of addiction
- Assess patients with drug or alcohol use disorders and other addictions
- Learn the biopsychosocial interventions for addictions

About our speaker:

Dr Soraya Mayet is a Consultant Psychiatrist Addictions Specialist employed by Humber Teaching NHS FT and provides clinical leadership to the fantastic East Riding Partnership (ERP) community addictions service. Dr Mayet combines clinical, teaching and research and has worked on three NICE guidelines as the Addictions expert. Dr Mayet has worked in addiction services across London, the North East and Yorkshire in a variety of settings including inpatient, community, prison and supervised injectable heroin clinic. Dr Mayet has experience of working with patients of all ages (from teenagers, to adults to those over 70 years), polysubstance use, dual diagnosis, chronic pain, pregnancy, criminal justice, prescription medication dependence or other complex issues. Dr Mayet loves teaching and regularly teaches and provides supervision to medical students, core psychiatry trainees, higher psychiatry trainees, psychiatrists, GPs, Addiction Non-Medical Prescribers and other healthcare professionals in Addictions.

Dr Mayet graduated as a doctor at University College London and completed an intercalated BSc in Physiology and Pharmacology with First Class Honours. Dr Mayet completed the majority of psychiatry training at the Maudsley Hospital scheme. Dr Mayet graduated with a Post Graduate Certificate in Academic Practice in 2008 and Doctorate in Medicine Research (MD Res) in 2010, both at Kings College London. Dr Mayet is on the GMC specialist register for general psychiatry and addictions. Dr Mayet is actively involved with a variety of research trials mainly focusing on addictions, with publications including the Lancet, and collaborating with a number of Universities nationally. Dr Mayet has provided input to the Department of Health and World Health Organisation on addictions.
